### Application Information

#### 1. Digital Portfolio

Your Portfolio should include: -

- (i) Curriculum Vitae
- (ii) Artist/Designer Statement (500 words)
- (iii) Examples of your art/craft/design work (past and/or present) – (20 images of work maximum).
- (iv) If you have teaching experience include images of students' art/craft/design work (Note: this is **not** a requirement)

#### 2. Interview (online)

The interview will last for 10-15 minutes and will be structured as follows: -

- (i) A three-minute verbal presentation by you in support of your application
- (ii) Questions by the interview panel
- (iii) There will be time at the close of the interview for you to ask a question(s).

### Interview Marking:

- Interpersonal and Communications Skills (including capacity for teamwork)-30 Marks
- Knowledge and Expertise in Art and Design-20 Marks
- Awareness of Current Educational/Social Issues-10 Marks
- Relevant Work Experience (not necessarily teaching)-10 Marks

### Portfolio and Writing Task Marking (distributed at interview):

- Creative Approach and Quality of Art/Design/Craft Work 40 Marks
- Portfolio Presentation and Coherence 10 Marks
- Competence to carry out Writing Task 15 Marks

- 2.2 – 5 Marks
- 2.1 - 10 Marks
- 1.1 - 12 Marks
- Masters – additional 8 Marks
- Other Qualifications – maximum additional 10 Marks
